<p><b>Vehicle:</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>•Get estimates from car transport or driver service companies if necessary.</li> </ul>	
<p><b>Computer:</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>•Back up all files and store the disks/CDs in a well protected place.</li> <li>•Check owner's manual for special packing instructions.</li> </ul>	
<p><b>Appliances:</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>•Ask the moving company if they handle appliances.</li> </ul>	
<p><b>Valuables:</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>•Make sure your moving company can handle items like a piano, pool table, fine art, or antiques.</li> <li>•Research special movers if you are doing a self-move.</li> <li>•Make sure your valuables are fully insured before you move.</li> </ul>
